



Sports Day Arrangements

We are looking forward to celebrating Sports Day on Wednesday 18th June. Please drop your child off to their classroom as usual. Our school gates will be locked as usual at 8.45 AM to ensure all children are registered.

EYFS/ KS1: The Sheerwater Road gate will be opened at 9 AM for a 9.15 AM start.KS2: The Sheerwater Road gate will be opened at 1 PM for a 1.15 PM start.These gates will then be locked and manned by a member of staff.As a reminder, please no food on the field and please no photographs to be taken.We will take photos and share these on our social media.

Attendance Matters



This week our our whole school attendance is 98.3%.

If your child is unwell and needs to be kept at home, you must call the school to inform us each day they are absent by 9am.

If your child is late for school you must accompany them to the school office to sign them in.



Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:
1. If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19 August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, per parent/carer per child, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.

2. If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19 August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, per parent/ carer per child, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.

3. If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, per parent/carer per child, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996.

Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

School Gate Timings



Thank you for ensuring your child arrives at school on time. Being ready to start the day is so very important for each child's learning.

Please ensure your child is not on site unsupervised before 8.30 AM.

All the teachers have an activity for the children to complete when they enter the classroom. This means learning starts as soon as the children sit down at their desks.
