








 continent	A group of countries	 village	A small town or community, often in the country.	 landmark	A point in a landscape that is used as a reference or marks a boundary.
 equator	The imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles.	 town	An area with streets, houses, and buildings that is larger than a village but usually smaller than a city.	 culture	A way of life for a group of people i.e. how they do things.
 oceans	A large area of salt water.	 traditions	Customs people have held over the years.	Human features	Features around you that have been created by humans.
 rivers	A large natural stream of fresh water flowing toward a lake or ocean.	 city	A large and important town where many people live and work.	Physical features	Features around you that have been created naturally.
