


Line is the path left by a moving point. It can be straight or curved and can be different in length.



Artists




Abstract means the work does not try to represent reality exactly. It uses shapes, colours and forms to express feeling or ideas.




Organic shapes are shapes that look natural, irregular and flowing.



Control means the way a drawing material is held.



Pressure means the force used on a material when drawing.



Portraits usually focus on the person's face and expression, because they tell us something about who they are and how they feel.
