	<b>ocean</b>	the body of salt water that is divided up and covers nearly three fourths of the surface of the earth		
	<b>equator</b>	an imaginary circle around the earth everywhere equally distant from the north pole and the south pole		
	<b>compass</b>	a device for determining directions by means of a magnetic needle		
	<b>polar region</b>	located at the very top and very bottom of the Earth. They are cold, with lots of wind, ice and snow		
	<b>human feature</b>	a feature of geography which has been built by humans e.g. a road		
	<b>physical feature</b>	a feature of geography which occurs naturally e.g. a mountain
