




 applique	When material is sewn or glued on to make a design	 embellish	To add decorative details
 cross-stitch	A stitch that crosses in an X	 pinking	Cutting fabric with zig-zag scissors
 running stitch	A basic sewing stitch	 template	Shows the shape that needs to be cut out
