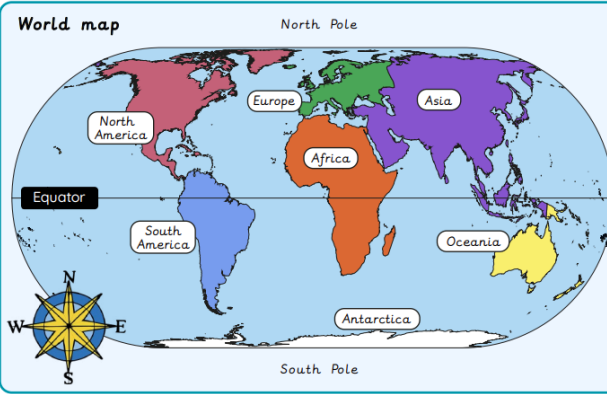
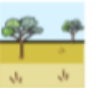

 continent	A very big piece of land on Earth. There are 7 continents.	temperature	 grasslands	Large areas of land covered mostly with grass and very few trees.	
 Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth that divides it into two halves. Places near it are usually hot.	 ice sheet	 rainforest	A hot, wet forest where it rains a lot and many plants and animals live.	
 polar	Describes places near the North or South Pole that are very cold.	 rain gauge	 thermometer	A tool used to measure how hot or cold something is (the temperature).	
 rural	A place in the countryside, with farms, fields and fewer people.	 savannah	physical feature	Something made by nature, not by people (like rivers or mountains).	
 climate	The usual weather in a place over a long time (for example, if it is often hot, cold, wet or dry)	 compass	human feature	Something made or built by people (like houses or roads)
