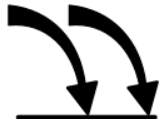
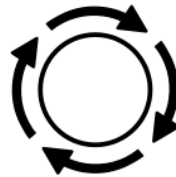

 ostinato	A repeating musical pattern	 a cappella	Singing with no musical accompaniment	 round	A song sung by two or more groups where one group starts and then the next group starts to sing the same song shortly after
 harmony	Playing or singing more than one pitched note at the same time	 cue	A signal (in either the music or from a conductor) which helps the performer know when to begin
