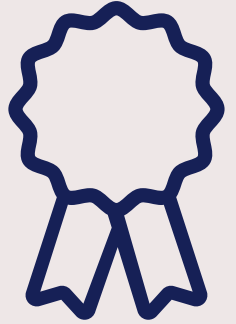

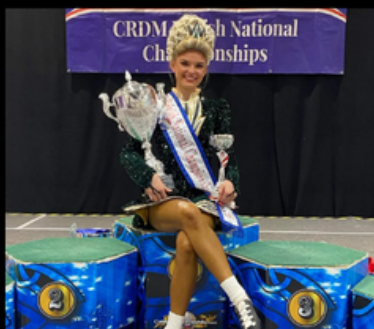


Parking

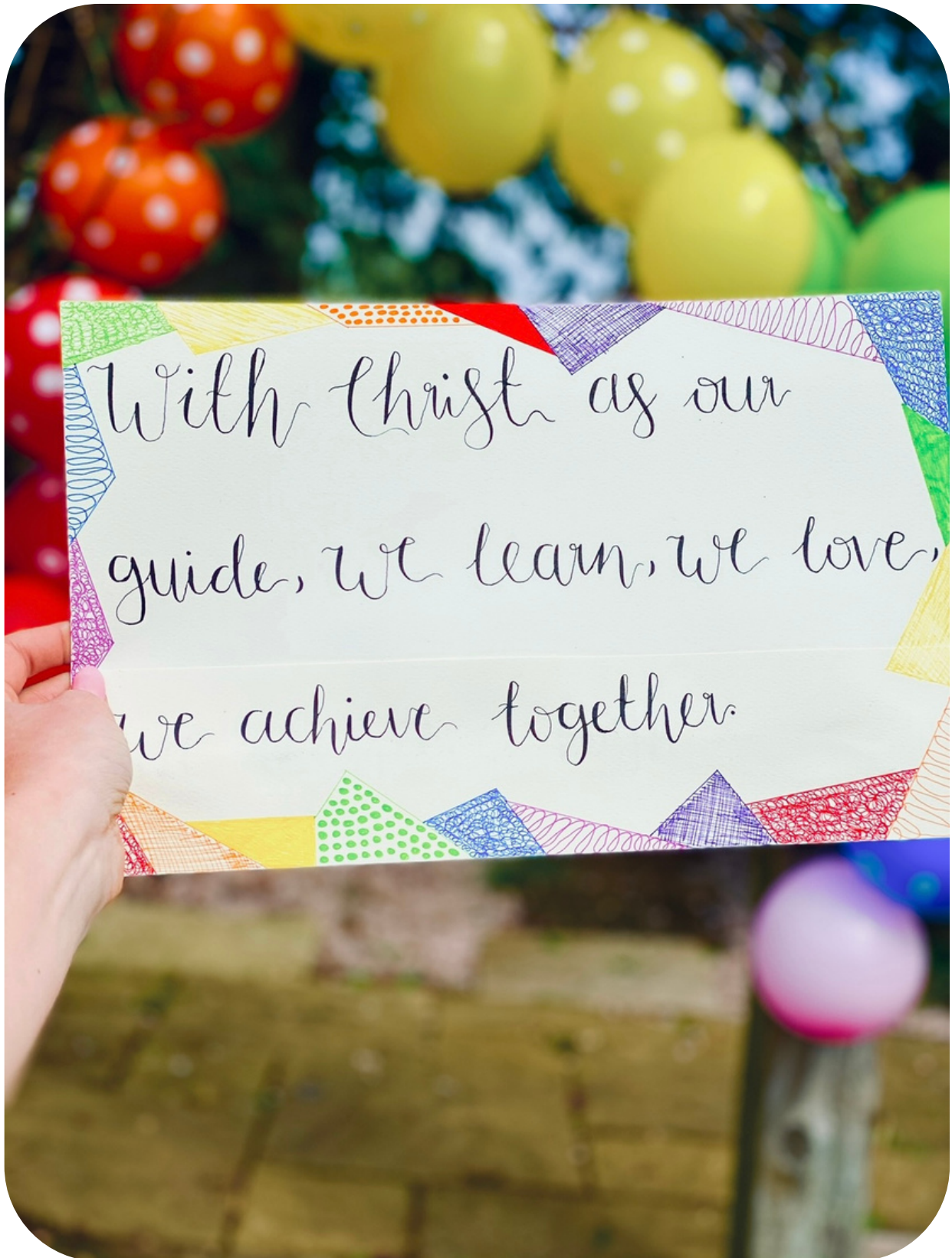
