If you will not be collecting your own child from the disco, you need to let us know. Please email pta@marist.surrey.sch.uk with details of your child's name, class and who will be collecting them ASAP. We will release children to their parents only unless we have been given advance notice in writing so please do let us know.

On entry to the disco, there will be a photo frame so that parents can take photos of their children before the event. It is your responsibility as a parent to ensure that you only take photos of children where you have obtained the permission of their parent or someone acting in loco parentis if someone else is dropping them off. We would also ask that to avoid any issues, you **do not upload these photos to social media**. If you do, please ensure that you seek full permission from other parents before uploading. The PTA nor the school will not be held responsible for any photos taken: we are providing this as a fun prop but are asking for parental support in ensuring it is used sensibly. Social media is not limited to Facebook or Instagram, but includes other apps such as WhatsApp and SnapChat etc.

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), they will be liable to receive a penalty notice.
