Learning Focus 1

The importance of Old Testament Women in Salvation History.

Women are the leading characters of many bible stories and God used them and their trust and faith in Him to lead His people back to Salvation.

The Magnificat is a poem of praise to God, spoken by Mary when she celebrated the news of her pregnancy with Elizabeth.

The Old Testament originates in Hebrew Scriptures. It is important for Christians because it speaks of God's covenant with Abraham and is the foundation of faith for Judaism and Christianity.

Luke intended his Gospel to be read by a Primarily Gentile audience and he presented Jesus Christ as the saviour of the Jews and Gentiles.

Matthean- are the writings from Matthew's Gospel. He wrote primarily for a Jewish audience.

A protagonist is a leading character or champion. They are people in the Bible who have great influence. Esther, Ruth, Deborah, Miriam and Hannah are examples of Protagonists in the Old Testament.

Mary is our Mother in Heaven. She was chosen by God for a special job. She is the new Eve and an example of a Protagonist in the Bible.

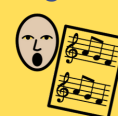
