ancient	Something from a long time ago.
architecture	The art and technique of designing and building.
Athenian	Person from the Greek city of Athens.
city states	Areas that ancient Greece was divided into: each state had their own government, laws and army.
civilisation	The people, culture and way of life of a certain area.
democracy	A political system where adults vote for an elected government who make decisions on how to run the country.
dictatorship	Form of government in which one person or a small group possesses absolute power.
empire	A group of countries which are ruled by one ruler or country.
legacy	Things that live on or are left behind after the end of a civilisation.
monarchy	A form of government with a monarch (king or queen) as the head.
Persian	People from Persia (now known as modern day Iran).
philosopher	Someone who studies the idea of right and wrong, the value of things and knowledge.
Spartans	People from the Greek city of Sparta.
