What is a prophet?

Advent begins on the Sunday closest to November 30th . It is a period of waiting and preparing for the arrival of Jesus.

A prophet has direct contact with God and the Holy Spirit. This gives them the ability to bring God's messages to people.

The prophets awaken an expectation of the coming of the Messiah in people's hearts.

Elijah was a prophet and is a Saint who lived about 900 years before the birth of Jesus, living in Israel or Samaria. He was a miracle worker

John the Baptist is sent to prepare the way for Jesus.

In the Advent liturgies, Christians pray for the second coming of Jesus alongside preparing for Christmas

Advent is a time of preparation for Jesus' incarnation at Christmas and for the second coming as King of the Universe

The tree of Jesse is a way of showing the ancestors of Jesus. Each one is on a branch of a tree from Jesse of Bethlehem, the father of King David.

Christ the King is one of the titles given to Jesus which means chosen or anointed. Jesus is our Servant King. He will be seated at the right hand of God when the Kingdom comes.







We think about the second coming of Jesus as King of the Universe.
