## Learning Focus 1

The Miracle of the Loaves

At the Last Supper Jesus showed his love by giving the gift of himself transformed into bread and wine.

He made his apostles priests of his promise when he told them to 'Do this in remembrance of me.'

The bread shared symbolizes Jesus' body which was broken on the cross, and the cup symbolizes His blood that was shed for sin.

Catholics gather to celebrate Mass where they listen to the words of holy scripture (the Liturgy of the Word).

Catholics gather to celebrate mass to meet Jesus in Holy Communion (the Liturgy of the Eucharist).

## Learning Focus 2

The Last Supper

A sacrament is a meeting point where people are blessed by God and become closer to the community of the Church.

The Eucharist is a sacrament in which Jesus offers his life for the salvation of the world. He is present in Holy Communion to be received by those who believe.

At the Last Supper Jesus instituted the Eucharist.

People give themselves to Jesus when they receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion).

The mass central part of Christian worship. The word comes from a Latin word which means "send out". During Mass, the sacrament of the Eucharist happens.
