Jesus is the Messiah; the Christ

A Jesus comes as a suffering servant, not a triumphant king.

Jesus is fully God and fully human. We call this belief the incarnation.

Jesus reveals the kind of messiah he is by showing that God's Kingdom includes those who are excluded by society

Jesus showed compassionate healing in mind and body through his ministry and continues to do so through His Body, the Church
