The events of Holy Week

Holy Week begins on Palm Sunday and marks the annual celebration of Jesus' passion, death, and resurrection.

The stations of the cross are a series of 14 images that tell the events of the Passion of Christ from his Condemnation to his placing in the tomb.

Pontius Pilate was the 5th Governor of the Roman governed Judaea. He served from about 26 AD to 37AD. He was the official at the trial of Jesus and ordered his crucifixion.

Pilate did not want to execute Jesus but listened to the crowds. "...he took water and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of the just person..."

The Romans The Romans used crucifixion as a punishment.

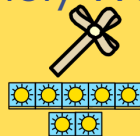
