



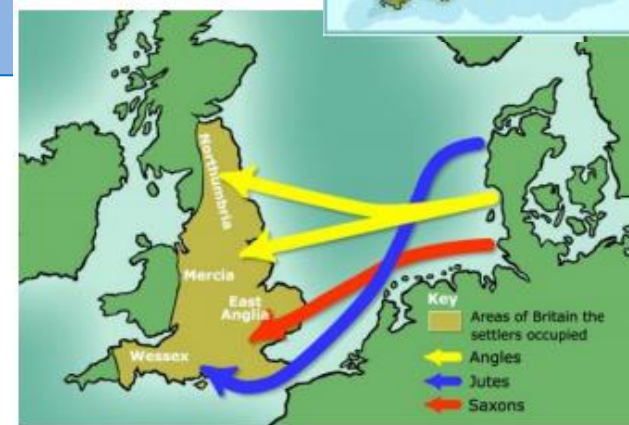
## Year 5 History~Anglo-Saxons

### Key Vocabulary

<b>AD / CE</b>	Anno Domini –Used with a date to show how many years since the birth of Christ. <i>Eg: it is now 2019 AD.</i> AD is sometimes replaced by CE which stands for <b>Common Era</b> .
<b>BC / BCE</b>	Used with a date to show the number of years <b>Before Christ</b> or <b>Before Common Era</b>
<b>century</b>	A hundred years
<b>invade</b>	Attack to try to take land
<b>village</b>	A small settlement
<b>settlement</b>	A place where people make their homes
<b>kingdom</b>	An area ruled by a King or Queen
<b>religion</b>	Belief in some sort of god or gods
<b>evidence</b>	Proof of something
<b>artefact</b>	A historical object
<b>tribe</b>	Group of people of the same culture
<b>monk</b>	A man who has devoted his life to his religion and lives in a religious community
<b>invaders</b>	People who attack and try to take land from other people
<b>raiders</b>	People who attack, then take what they find away with them.
<b>Paganism</b>	The religion of the Anglo-Saxons who believed in many gods
<b>Christianity</b>	The religion of the Romans, based on the teachings of Jesus and belief in one God.
<b>monastery</b>	Building where monks live

We will learn about the invasions of the Anglo-Saxons in the 5th century.

We will find out where the invading troops came from and where in Britain they managed to settle. You will go on to investigate how life in Britain changed as a result.
